## COVID-19 Rules& Regulations

The Clubs continue to finalize Covid-19 related protocols, as necessary, to protect Participants and the Clubs. However, as of the date of this premium, we are implementing the following guidelines to adhere to. The club reserves the right to amend or implement additional procedures as appropriate:

1. If you are not comfortable with the protocols in place– Do Not Come.
2. If you are sick in any way or have tested positive for Covid-19 without a subsequent negative test result– Do Not Come.
3. Signs for Social Distancing will be posted as reminders, so pay attention
4. Parking: Park with sufficient distance between vehicles if possible.
5. Masks are to be the exhibitor's responsibility. PLEASE BE PREPARED TO BE SELF-SUFFICIENT AND RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR FACE COVERING.
6. MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.
7. Practice Social Distancing. Wash or sanitize hands frequently. Avoid shaking hands, hugging or any physical contact. Hand sanitizing stations will be around the outside of the ring. Please visit frequently.
8. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Hand sanitizing will be around the outside of the ring. Please visit frequently.
9. Show Area: The ring will be increased in size to accommodate social distancing within the ring. Please follow all instructions from the Judge and the Steward to maintain that distance.
10. The ready ring will also be expanded to accommodate social distancing. Only one class at a time will be allowed in the ready ring. Once that class has entered the show ring, the next class may enter the ready ring. This will be strictly adhered to.
11. Exhibitors will be asked to show the bite of their dog.
12. There will be two openings in the show ring; one for an entrance and one for an exit going out. Please adhere to this.
13. Any violations of these protocols will be dealt with by the Show Committee immediately, up to and including a bench hearing & removal from the show grounds.

The Amateur Owner-Handler shall be for dogs that are at least 6 months of age, that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by their registered owner. The class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class. (Chapter 11, Section 13)

#### \*\* Bred-By-Exhibitors Class/Best of Bred By in Best of Breed Competition Eligibility (revised 9/20)

All dogs entered in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record and owner of record of the dog. To exhibit this class, a family member must be a breeder and owner of record.

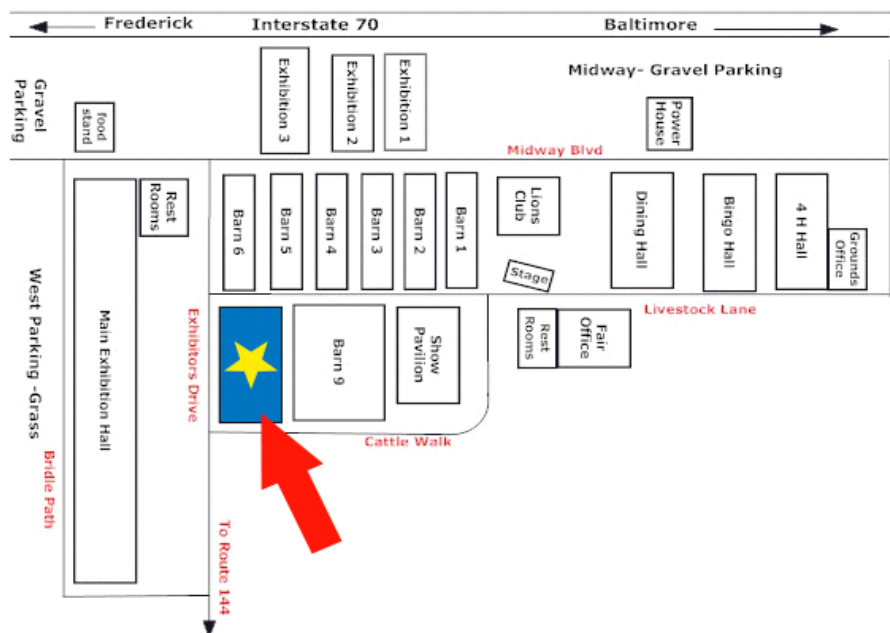

## NOHS Eligibility

- Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
  - Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.
  - Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
  - Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
- Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club, Phone: 919-233-9767. For additional information, contact American Kennel Club, Junior Showmanship, PO Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675. Phone: 919-233-9767 or Email: juniors@akc.org. Entry blank MUST be filled out with necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

**NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 First Place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.
