Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class. (Chapter 11, Section 13)

** Bred-By-Exhibitors Class/Best of Bred By in Best of Breed Competition Eligibility (revised 9/20)

All dogs entered in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record and owner of record of the dog. To exhibit this class, a family member must be a breeder and owner of record.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

COVID-19 Rules& Regulations

The Clubs continue to finalize Covid-19 related protocols, as necessary, to protect Participants and the Clubs. 

ENTRIES MUST BE ON AN OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM. Photocopies of entry form will be accepted only with agreements and rules on the reverse side of the form.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as possible with tickets and/or identification cards. The Person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. Should acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor in a reasonable time, notify Donna Lapoint, 410-489-5375

A \$3.00 AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE AND A RECORDING FEE OF \$0.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These Event Service and Recording Fees are to be collected by the Show–giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If the dog is entered in more than one class in the show, these fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Club Rule, Chapter 14 Section 2).

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. In the event of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, and if it becomes impossible or unsafe to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as (but not limited to) snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dog, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show, no refund of entry fee shall be made.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in being put on a cash-only basis.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.
